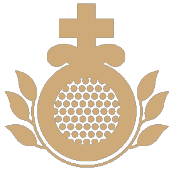
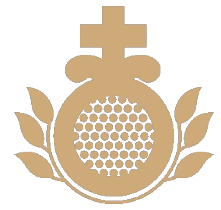

Saint John of God Community Services helps service users find their own home.

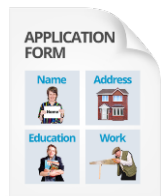


Your Support Worker will give you information.

Sometimes it can be in a house owned by Saint John of God Community Services.

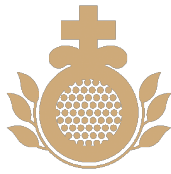


You will have to apply to Saint John of God Community Services.

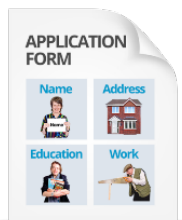
You will pay a weekly charge, which will cover groceries, household maintenance, utility bills, etc.
