Depending on where you live, the Council will assess your income and your need of housing.



If you pass the assessment, you will go on the Council's housing waiting list.

But if you don't like it, you can refuse.

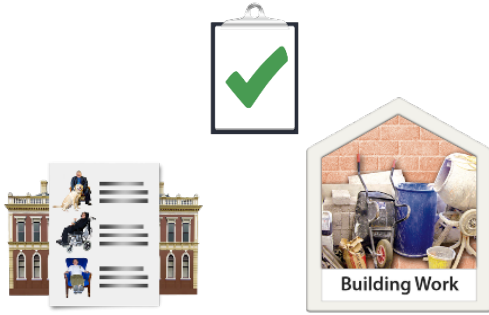
You can only refuse an offer of housing twice.



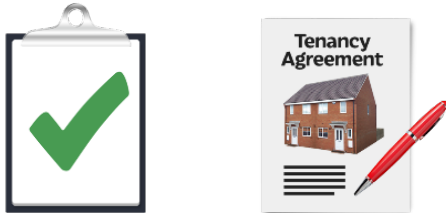
If you accept, your rent will be based on your income.



Your rent will be affordable.



The council is then responsible for all the repairs on your property



You have to keep within the terms of your Tenancy Agreement

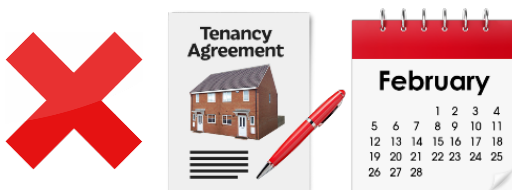


Your rent can go up or down according to your income, your rent can be reviewed once a year.



You can apply for a grant to help you purchase furniture and white goods in your new home.

If you ever want to leave your home, you will have to give minimum notice to the Council.
