



responsibility tell people	I have the responsibility to tell people I am having a problem.

other feelings ideas people people	Other people have feelings and ideas too.
they tell me	They can tell me about their feelings and their ideas.
respect people's feelings	I need to respect other people's feelings and ideas.
responsibility respect	I have the responsibility to respect other people's feelings and ideas.
